2020 Scholarship Program

The Honourable Company of Air Pilots, Australian Region, in conjunction with a number of industry partners, are pleased to announce the availability of several scholarships to assist aspiring professional pilots as set out below.



Aspeq, Assessment Specialists is an independent commercial company, delegated by CASA, to supervise the Professional Pilot Licence exams in Australia.

Two scholarships will be provided, one to cover the cost of Commercial Pilots Licence Exams the other to cover the cost of Airline Transport Pilot Licence Exams, each to the value of over \$1000

Advanced Flight Theory

Advanced Flight Theory (AFT) is a specialist aviation theory school based at the Sunshine Coast Airport, Queensland, Australia offering the highest quality, fully accredited ATPL (Airline Transport Pilot Licence) theory course.

AFT will provide a scholarship to cover the cost of one ATPL theory course valued at \$4990, which provides a combination of full-time ground school in class on the Sunshine Coast plus self study distance learning.



Online Aviation Theory provides a guided self study course from PPL, through CPL and up to ATPL theory level via an online portal covering both the aeroplane and helicopter syllabus.

OAT will provide one scholarship for 12 months access to cover study through to ATPL level valued at \$1300.



Southern Cross Flight Simulator Services based at Goolwa airport, South Australia, is a leading provider of simulator instruction towards the requirements for an Instrument Rating.

SCFSS will provide two scholarships of 20 hours simulator instruction each towards the award of an instrument rating under the tutelage of one of the most experienced and qualified instructors in the industry. The course can only be undertaken at Goolwa and candidates will need to arrange the aircraft component of their instrument rating themselves.



Aviation Australia is a world class, registered training organisation, offering courses in cabin crew, engineering and pilot training to aspiring individuals, looking to pursue a career in the aviation industry.

Aviation Australia are pleased to offer a place on one of their Multi Crew Cooperation courses designed to provide you with the team skills you need to work effectively as a pilot on a modern-day flight deck in a multi-crew airline environment. At the end of the week long course you will receive a formal Certificate of Completion as well as logbook endorsement of competence. Many airlines consider completion of this course as an advantage in pilot applicants. The nominal value of the course is \$6,000.

The Honourable Company of Air Pilots, Education Trust will provide an additional scholarship to a candidate that it believes will provide the most benefit. The nature of the scholarship will be at the Trust's discretion.

Minimum Requirements

General Requirements. Applicants:

- must be normally resident in Australia
- must have passed a Class 1 Medical

For ATPL Theory Course and Exams, Applicants:

- must hold a Private Pilots Licence or higher
- must have a minimum 100 hours total flying time

For CPL Theory and Exams, Applicants

- must hold a Recreational Pilots Licence or higher or similar standard for helicopters
- must have a minimum 40 hours total flying time

For SCFSS Scholarship, Applicants:

- must have passed the CASA Instrument Rating Exam (IREX)
- must have a MEA Class Rating
- must have a PPL or higher

NOTE: This scholarship can only be undertaken at SCFSS premises at Goolwa Airport, Sth Australia

For Aviation Australia MCC course

- must hold a CPL or higher
- must have a pass in ATPL Human Factors
- must hold or have held an Instrument Rating (does not need to be current)

NOTE: The course will be conducted in Brisbane on an as available basis and consists of 3 days pre-course self study with an on line assessment followed by 2 days ground school and 5 sim sessions.

Other Requirements

Shortlisted candidates will be expected to provide:

- documentary evidence that they meet the minimum requirements
- a reference from the CFI or HOO of their current training organisation or other significant aviation person.
- a current photograph

General Conditions

- All scholarships will be available for 12 months from the date of the award. Any scholarship item(s) not completed within the 12 month period will lapse.
- The scholarship is personal to the recipient and cannot therefore be transferred to another, or redeemed for cash or kind.
- CPL and ATPL Examinations may be taken at any of the Aspeq examination centres in Australia
- Exam scholarships cover the first attempt only. Subsequent attempts, if necessary, will be at the candidate's expense.
- The recipient will ensure that when they are taking the awarded examinations that their conduct will be accordance with the CASA and Aspeq examination and rules and procedures.

The Scholarship Organisers:

- Will not extend the validity time of the scholarship.
- Decision as to the selection of the recipient is final.
- Reserve the right not to present the scholarship if, in the judgement of the selection panel, none of the applicants meet the selection criteria.
